We will be using the curriculum <i>Call to Faith</i>, which focuses on prayer, scripture and Tradition, and fun activities—building blocks for lifelong catechesis. Service projects & special events will be planned, and parent education classes will also be an option during class times. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Special Education</u> is a weekly class designed for those with special needs, to focus on learning more about loving and serving God, the Church, and each other. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Confirmation (9th – 12th grades)</u> is a one-year program meeting every week except holidays. Sponsors need to be chosen early and are required to attend some of the meetings; if they cannot be present, a parent or guardian must be there. A retreat is also required TBA in the month of January. Baptism, First Eucharist, and Reconciliation are prerequisites. If you do not have these sacraments, please let us know so we can get started. Candidates will need a Bible and their Catholic Youth Handbook (included in registration costs) and need to have access to a copy of the Catholic Catechism at home. We will be using a curriculum known as Total Catechesis, which breaks the faith down by the four pillars of the Church: the Creed, Liturgy and Sacraments, Christian Morality, and Christian Prayer (Saint Mary's Press). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Junior High (7th and 8th grades)</u> will be meeting for an infusion youth group. We will be teaching a Catechetical program that takes a fun approach to learning. 7th and 8th graders will build community as well as an individual spiritual understanding of the faith through the program Catholic Connections (Saint Mary's Press). Students are required to bring their Bibles to the meetings (a recommendation for a Bible would be The Saint Mary's Press Catholic Youth Bible) and their Catholic Connections Handbook (included in registration costs). Once per month, parents are required to come to the Saint Jude Education night, which will fall on Wednesday nights and supplement the meetings on those nights.
